

Hi,

I hope everyone is having a good half term! This is an email for all the seniors taking part in New Theatre Oxford show on Sat 16th March 2024.

<u>Plan for the day:</u>

- Organise your travel and leave enough time to get there early please do not be late as we only have one rehearsal slot.
- REMEMBER: to bring your tickets if you are watching, the girls costumes, and their additional items (see details below).
- 10:30am: Arrive at New Theatre Oxford, with hair and makeup done. Please arrive wearing clean trainers, dance leotard, tracksuit with zip hood. Make sure hair is up (make up can be done during LUNCH BREAK (see below).
- 10:50 11:10am: Tech session (wearing tracksuits) spacing and lighting for our numbers.
- 12-12:20pm: Rehearsal of opening number (wearing tracksuits).
- 12:30 2:30pm: <u>LUNCH BREAK</u> you can pick your children up should you wish to go for a family lunch or leave them with us, but you must inform us at drop off which you are doing.
- 2:30pm: Back at theatre and get into costume. <u>Hair and makeup</u> <u>MUST be done.</u>
- 3:30 4:30pm: Full dress rehearsal. Straight after Act 1 girls will break for tea. We will be looking at taking the girls to Pizza Hut if they want a hot meal, or they can stay on site if they prefer a packed lunch. For those going to Pizza Hut we ask for a £10 contribution. If your child has specific dietary requirements then they are welcome to buy a personal pizza rather than share with the group.
- 4:30 5pm: Back at theatre for show.
- 6pm: Show curtains up both our junior dance and senior dance are in Act 1.

• 8pm: Estimated time of finish.

SIGNING IN AND OUT - You must sign in and out with Miss Rosie.

<u>HAIR</u>

SENIORS - as per your Barbie

Hair should be styled inline with your Barbie. Ballerina barbie would have a bun. Over played with Barbie hair would be wild!

MAKE UP

Stage makeup (apply more than you usually would as it can appear washed out on stage) – this can be done in the LUNCH BREAK if you are taking them out.

SENIORS - Makeup should be Stage and heavier but again should match your Barbie style. Goth Barbie would be black lipstick. Pink might be pink and Pop Barbie would be Red!?

COSTUMES

SENIOR - Barbie

Each girl is to choose their own barbie "costume" styled as Barbie. For example: Sporty Barbie, Traditional Barbie, Swim Star Barbie, Ballerina Barbie, etc. Please consider IF the costume needs hot pants on underneath. Shoes should be appropriate to the Barbie they have chosen, and they must be able to dance in them! Please do not feel you have to go out and buy specific stuff. Please borrow and think what students already have. Ask Miss Rosie if you are finding it difficult.

No additional clothes are needed for the finale we will be wearing our costumes.

<u>TIPS for the day – things to pack:</u>

 Please pack lots of water/juice (no fizzy drinks). Packed tea (if required – see earlier note) and snacks (no eggs, nuts or chocolate).

- Pack make-up so we can top it up.
- Pack hair bits so we can tidy hair if needed.
- Pack costumes in a suit bag, on hangers. Suit bag to be named
- Please pack some baby talc in bag this helps girls get tights on and off when hot.
- <u>NAME EVERYTHING!</u>
- Have one bag for food and drinks. Remember your child needs to be able to carry her own things... Consider a SMALL wheelie bag for little ones with a lunchbox carried separately.
